

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 12 August 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to suitable people and concerns about children's safety and welfare.

On 30 October 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found that the provider had failed to notify Ofsted of a significant event, which is a requirement of their registration. We also found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 14 November 2025:

- consistently apply the well understood safeguarding policy in practice to manage any concerns raised about staff suitability appropriately and in line with requirements.

On 12 November 2025, the provider responded to the action set. They reassured us that they have taken the correct action to retrospectively speak to and take advice from relevant agencies about certain matters. The provider has also implemented new processes to determine the on-going suitability of their staff on a regular basis. They have spoken to their staff team and reiterated their expectations in relation to this as well.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
