

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 21 July 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to suitable people.

On 8 October 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 27 October 2025:

- ensure any person who may have regular contact with children is suitable
- ensure you understand your roles and responsibilities linked to disqualification under the Childcare Act 2006.

On 20 October 2025, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider has reviewed and strengthened their recruitment procedures for assistants and enhanced supervision practices. This includes regular, detailed discussions regarding staff's ongoing suitability, contributing to more robust suitability assessments. The information gathered suggests that the provider is now meeting the requirements of their registration. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
