

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the [Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage](#). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 17 April 2026 and 22 April 2026, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements 3.79 Safety of premises, 3.42 Staff: child ratios, 3.102 Changes that must be notified to Ofsted, 3.41 Key person, 3.77 Accident or injury, and 3.91 Risk assessments. On 28 April 2026, we carried out an unannounced regulatory visit. We found that risk assessments were not effective to identify and minimise all hazards to children, and bathrooms children use are not kept clean and hygienic at all times. Following this visit, we issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

■ Actions needed by 8 May 2026:

ensure effective risk assessments are completed, particularly in the outdoor play areas, to ensure any risks to children's health, safety and wellbeing are identified and removed or minimised

ensure bathrooms and nappy changing areas are kept clean and hygienic at all times.

On 11 May 2026, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had improved their risk assessments. These have been reviewed with staff to ensure they understand their responsibilities and ensure consistency. Staff have been reminded of the setting's health and safety policies and completed further training in health and safety in the workplace. Additional monitoring of risk assessments is being implemented. Cleaning schedules have been reviewed and reinforced with staff to ensure regular checks and high hygiene standards are maintained throughout the day. These are being monitored by leaders. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply

with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
