

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 10 June 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to suitable people, safeguarding policies and procedures and concerns about children's safety and welfare.

The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

On 29 July 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has notified local safeguarding agencies of their concerns, developed their allergy management processes and developed staff's knowledge on whistleblowing. However, we found the provider was not meeting the requirements for suitable people. We have issued actions for the provider to take.

Actions needed by 26 August 2025

- ensure leaders understand and follow safe recruitment procedures for all staff to ensure their suitability.

On 26 August 2025, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of safer recruitment processes. There is now a comprehensive process in place for recruitment and staff have attended training to develop their knowledge. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. We are satisfied that the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our

responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
