## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands the importance of providing activities and resources to meet the needs of children with different ages, abilities and backgrounds. She also knows how to monitor and support their learning.
- The childminder knows the procedures to follow if she has a concern about a child's welfare. She is aware of how to keep the premises free from hazards so that children can play safely.
- The childminder keeps her first-aid certificate updated and ensures she has the relevant insurance. She understands the requirements and the correct procedures for recording accidents and medication administration.
- The childminder understands the importance of providing children with a healthy lifestyle. She knows how to encourage positive behaviour from children.
- The childminder understands the importance of training and self-evaluation in improving the provision for children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## Inspection activities

- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she intends to meet the safeguarding and welfare requirements when minding children.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she intends to deliver the educational programmes for children.
- The inspector discussed record keeping, policies and procedures with the childminder.
