

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 7 October 2024, the provider notified us about safeguarding and policies and procedures. This notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted an allegation made against a staff member.

On 8 November 2024, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found that the provider had followed appropriate safeguarding procedures. During the regulatory call on 8 November 2024, we found a new area of concern. This means that the provider was not meeting other requirements as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage. In relation to the new area of concern, we issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 11 November 2024:

- ensure that Ofsted is provided with details of all those connected with the setting, such as directors, so that required suitability checks can be carried out.

We are satisfied with the action taken by the provider. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
