

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at <http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2>. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 19 November 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment and staff-to-child ratios. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage' to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 14 and 15 January 2026, we carried out regulatory telephone calls. We found that the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 5 February 2026:

- ensure risk assessment procedures are fully effective in supporting staff to identify and remove any risks.

On 2 February 2026, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had provided all staff with risk assessment training to improve their knowledge and understanding. During a team meeting, staff have actively risk assessed the nursery to embed understanding of the setting's procedures when identifying and addressing potential risks to children.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
