

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 12 March 2026, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to staff: child ratios, supporting and understanding children's behaviour and safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment.

On 16 March 2026, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 7 April 2026:

- ensure the correct ratios are maintained at all times
- improve outing risk assessments to reduce hazards and ensure children are kept in sight at all times.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the actions are successfully completed.

On 13 May 2026, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that they had strengthened their risk assessments for outings and demonstrated how they were able to meet the staff: child ratios. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to

bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
