

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 15 May 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to changes that must be notified to Ofsted or the relevant childminder agency.

On 19 May 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting one of the requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take.

Action needed by 4 June 2025:

- ensure that Ofsted are notified of changes to all persons aged 16 years or older living or working on the premises within the required time frame to enable all suitability checks to be completed promptly.

A regulatory monitoring visit was completed on 8 July 2025. The provider has developed her understanding of the notification requirements to support children's safety and welfare. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
