

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at

www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 28 and 29 April 2026, we received information that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements, including keeping children within sight or hearing at all times, and that the premises may not be appropriately organised for confidentiality and safeguarding.

On 14 May 2026, we carried out a regulatory visit. During this visit, we found that the provider had failed to provide a safe and secure premises for children and ensure that they were always within sight or hearing. However, they have taken swift and appropriate action to correct this. The provider has put measures in place, such as securing higher, out of reach locks on all doors, reviewing and improving transition periods and room procedures and improving risk assessments to ensure that they have minimised the risk of this happening again in the future. Ofsted are satisfied that the provider fully understands their responsibility to provide an environment for children that is organised appropriately for confidentiality and safeguarding, and to ensure that children are always within sight or hearing at all times. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to

bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
