

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 28 February 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to concerns about children's safety and welfare, and safeguarding policies and procedures. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

On 22 and 24 April 2025, we carried out regulatory telephone calls. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 09 May 2025:

- ensure that leaders implement robust safeguarding policies and procedures that are in line with the local safeguarding partnerships, particularly in relation to managing allegations against staff
- ensure the safeguarding policy clearly sets out the action to be taken in the event of an allegation being made against a member of staff.

On 8 May 2025, the provider responded to the actions set. On 13 May 2025, we requested further information, and the provider responded on the same day. We found that the

provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of managing allegations against staff. They had also clarified the procedures for managing allegations against staff in their safeguarding policy.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
