## Summary of key findings

### This provision does not meet requirements

- The childminder does not hold an valid paediatric first aid qualification, to ensure she has an up-to-date knowledge and understanding of how to respond to accidents and illness. This is a requirement of registration.
- During discussion, the childminder explains how she plans her provision to meet the needs of children. She states that she plans based on the ages and stages of children and gathers information from parents about children's interests and needs. She describes how she provides activities and experiences for children that build on these.
- The childminder shows an understanding of how to manage children's behaviour. For example, she talks about the positive behaviour she observes in the children. She explains that she sets clear boundaries when children start attending. She says she engages in games with children where they learn about turn taking and sharing. She explains that she focuses on helping children to be kind and considerate to each other.
- The childminder explains how she promotes children's personal development, for instance by giving opportunities to make choices. She talks about how she encourages them to build positive relationships with their peers. She says she engages in games with children where they learn about turn-taking and sharing. She says this help to teach them about being kind and considerate to each other.
- The childminder talks about how she works with the local school and preschool to share information to provide a consistent and cohesive approach to caring for children. She understands the need to build positive relationships with other professionals that help in supporting children's learning.
- The childminder talks about how she accesses online learning to help keep her skills and knowledge up to date.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
