

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at

www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 29 July 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to safeguarding policies and procedures, concerns about children's safety and welfare, and information about the child. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

On 09 December 2025, we conducted a regulatory telephone call and found that the provider was not meeting one requirement and had taken immediate action to address this. The provider has reviewed nursery practices and ensured greater safety for children. The provider and staff completed reflection sessions and improved safeguarding policies and procedures. They now follow robust procedures to notify the local authority children's social care team of any concerns about a child. The provider can give parents more information about these changes. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
