

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 28 January 2026 we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to concerns about children's safety and welfare. On 28 and 29 January 2026, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting a requirement related to staff: child ratios. In addition, the childminder had not notified Ofsted of a significant event. The provider now understands what she needs to notify Ofsted of.

We have served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out.

Actions needed by 13 February 2026:

- ensure staffing arrangements always meet children's needs.

We have monitored the provider's response and have ensured the action has been successfully completed. The provider is meeting the early years foundation stage requirements. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
