

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 5 December 2024, the provider notified us about a significant event relating to Safeguarding policies and procedures and concerns about children's safety and welfare

The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of any significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of any persons who cares for children or has regular contact with children on the premises.

On 8 January 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit to the setting. We found that the provider has procedures in place to ensure staff have a clear understanding of how to safeguard children. We found that the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider completed a thorough investigation. All practitioners have received further training on procedures to ensure they are effectively deployed in the setting. They have completed refresher training to ensure when children transition around the nursery they are effectively supervised.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to

bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
