

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundationstage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 21 May 2026, the provider notified us about matters relating to organising premises for confidentiality and safeguarding, risk assessment and training and skills. This was in relation to older children leaving the premises. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of any significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of the early years provider to look after children. We subsequently received concerns relating to the same incident on 2 and 10 June 2026.

On 12 June 2026, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider conducted a thorough investigation. This resulted in changes made to procedures when children move around the premises including more frequent head counts. Changes were made to the premises which included additional barriers in place to prevent access to areas and raising the height of access devices. Safety plans were introduced to meet children's specific needs. All staff revisited training and policies and procedures. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
