

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 5 June 2024, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. On 18 June 2024, we completed a regulatory visit. We found that the provider had an area adequately equipped to provide healthy meals, snacks and drinks for children.

We also found that the provider was not meeting some other requirements. We served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the action below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 30 July 2024:

- ensure the premises comply with requirements of health and safety legislation and hygiene requirements
- improve risk assessment procedures to ensure children are not exposed to risks.

On 5 August 2024, we carried out a regulatory visit to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised at the last visit. We found that the provider has implemented clear procedures to ensure the setting continues to meet the health and safety legislation and hygiene requirements. The nursery is clean and well-ventilated. Improved risk assessment procedures have been implemented to ensure children are not exposed to risks. Staff have been trained in these procedures to ensure they are implemented consistently. Leaders have introduced new monitoring systems to oversee the health and safety, hygiene and risk assessment procedures in the setting.

We are satisfied with the action taken by the provider.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
