

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 26 June 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to suitable people, information and record keeping and other legal duties.

On 7 August 2025 and 14 August 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone calls. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. They have taken steps to improve their data protection procedures. Additional training has been given to senior staff to help them understand how to ensure the safe storage of children's information.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

We publish details of complaints made against childminders, home childcarers and childcare providers where we or the provider have taken action in order to meet legal requirements.
