

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 17 September 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to staff: child ratios, suitable people, health and other legal duties.

On 22 December 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to suitable people. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted.

On 21 January 2026, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 04 February 2026

- ensure staff understand and implement safe sleep practices for babies and young children
- ensure that facilities and areas for nappy changing and toileting are clean and hygienic
- ensure that risk assessments are known and understood by all staff to effectively identify and minimise risks to children
- improve staff's knowledge and understanding of how to manoeuvre babies and children safely

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the actions are successfully completed. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

On 3 February 2026, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of safe sleep practices, risk assessments and how to move babies and children safely. Additionally, the provider has implemented role modelling and coaching with staff to improve practice. Systems and checks have been reviewed to ensure that nappy changing and toileting areas hygienic. The provider has supported staff to understand expectations and the policies within the setting. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
