

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at <http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2>. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 12 February 2025, we received a concern that the provider may not be meeting requirements relating to Safeguarding policies and procedures.

On 27 February 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit and found that the provider has effective safeguarding policies and procedures in place and staff know the action to take if they have concerns about the safety and welfare of a child. However, we also found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 7 March 2025:

- ensure that staff and managers understand any revisions to the risk assessments of the premises because of onsite building work, so that they can demonstrate how they are managing risks and children are not exposed to risks.

On 5 March 2025, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had shared the risk assessment with all staff who are now fully briefed on the building work. Daily risk assessment checklists have been introduced and are completed by managers who will make appropriate adjustments as required.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
