

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', (EYFS) which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 21 Aug 2025 we carried out a routine inspection of the early years provision. We served a Welfare Requirements Notice in relations to breaches of EYFS requirements found at that inspection. The related actions are set out in the published inspection report.

We carried out an unannounced monitoring visit 30 September 2025, and a subsequent regulatory telephone call to ensure that the childminder had complied with the actions raised. We were satisfied that all actions had been met in timely manner. The next step will be a reinspection within six months of the previous inspection. The provider remains registered.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
