

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 24 May 2024, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 5 June 2024, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 27 June November 2024:

- ensure Ofsted is informed of all adults living and/or working on the premises so that the required checks are completed to make sure adults living and/or working in the home are suitable

- make sure correct adult to child ratios are always adhered to and is in line with the requirement that only assistants whose suitability has been confirmed by Ofsted are included in the ratio

- ensure that there is at least one person with a full paediatric first aid certificate on the premises at all times and during outings, and make sure that there are adequate first aider arrangements to quickly respond to any emergencies in relation to the number of children and assistants present and the layout of the premises

- implement good hygiene measures to support children's good health and well-being

- ensure children are engaged in consistent and purposeful play and activities and that adult interactions support their needs, including promoting their understanding of positive behaviours.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the actions are successfully completed.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
