

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 March 2026, the provider notified us about matters relating to accident or injury, safety of premises, risk assessment, training and skills, supervision of staff, staff: child ratios and paediatric first aid. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of any serious accident to any child while in their care.

On 3 July 2026, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. This included ensuring that all accidents children sustain are reported to leaders immediately so that they can use the systems in place to verify accidents and ensure information is shared promptly with parents and carers. The provider has improved staff knowledge of completing accident forms accurately and understanding the consequences of inaccurate reporting. Measures have been implemented to ensure that accident records provide a detailed and reliable account of what happened. In addition, the provider has strengthened staff practice in the safe handling of children and improved arrangements for paediatric first aid. This supports children's safety and welfare.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
