

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2.

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 28 January 2025, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

The report and inspection outcome will be published in due course. Following the inspection, we served a welfare requirements notice on 5 February 2025. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 4 February 2025:

- ensure children are within sight and hearing while they eat

On 10 February 2025 we served a further welfare requirements notice.

Actions needed by 7 March 2025:

- develop a secure knowledge of how to respond to and report any safeguarding concerns about children, and how to manage allegations against adults, including how to report

these to the appropriate agencies

- develop the knowledge and skills required to support children in their understanding of behavioural expectations
- ensure professional development is targeted to improve the quality of education to a good standard.

On 10 February 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. The focus of the call was to check whether the provider had met one of the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection.

We found that the provider had reviewed practice to ensure children are within sight and hearing at all times when eating. This ensures the safety and wellbeing of children.

On 17 February 2025, the provider notified us of their wish to resign their registration. Consequently, we were unable to monitor the provider's progress in meeting the additional actions raised at their last inspection. The provider is no longer registered with Ofsted.
