Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder knows how to support children's learning and has suitable systems to help her monitor and assess their development. She knows how to observe children during their play and to plan activities that support the next steps in their learning. She is aware of how to support children to gain the skills they need for their future learning.
- The childminder knows how to support good behaviour and help children to be considerate and respectful of others. She recognises the importance of supporting children's understanding of diversity and healthy lifestyle choices.
- The childminder is aware of the safeguarding and welfare requirements. She is clear about child protection matters, current legislation and the procedures to follow to help safeguard children.
- The childminder understands the importance of working in partnership with parents. She knows to encourage two-way communication about children's welfare and learning.
- The childminder understands the need to evaluate her practice and develop her skills. She researches good practice and shares ideas with other early years professionals.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
