The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a sound understanding of child protection issues and procedures to ensure children are safeguarded.
- The childminder is fully aware of the importance of working in close partnership with parents and others involved in children's care to meet children's individual needs.
- The childminder understands the learning and development requirements. She knows how to use observation and assessments to support children's play and progress.
- The childminder knows how to use reflective practice to promote positive outcomes for children. She has attended courses to support her professional development and promote children's learning.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation.
