

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 20 May 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take.

Actions needed by 03 June 2025:

- ensure good hygiene and cleanliness procedures are followed at all times, and ensure there are clean facilities for the hygienic preparation of food to promote children's good health
- ensure overall indoor floor space is fit for purpose and suitable for the age of children cared for on the premises
- ensure that there are thorough and regular risk assessments of all environments and equipment accessed by children to ensure they are safe for use.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the actions are successfully completed.

On 3 June 2025, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had implemented risk assessments for the areas used by children to ensure that they are safe and suitable. She has also ensured that areas used for food preparation and spaces that children play are clean and hygienic. We are satisfied the provider has met the actions raised.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
