

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 14 May 2025, the provider notified us of some information relating to: Safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of any serious accident, illness, or injury to, or death of, any child while in their care, and of the action taken.

On 5 June 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider had taken appropriate action to prevent a similar incident happening again. For example, they have ensured that the carpet and stair treads are securely fitted and they have also fitted bright strips to highlight better where steps start and end. In addition, staff have been reminded about the procedure for supporting children when using the stairs. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted. We are satisfied with the action taken by the provider.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
