Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder has improved her practice since the last inspection and addressed the action raised at the last visit. She now has an up-to-date paediatric first-aid qualification. This demonstrates a positive commitment to improve.
- The childminder has a suitable knowledge and understanding of how to observe and monitor children's developmental progress to ensure they make progress.
- The childminder maintains a clean and safe environment for the children to play and rest within, which contributes to children's health and well-being.
- The childminder has a suitable understanding of her roles and responsibilities for safeguarding children.
- The childminder understands the importance of working in partnership with parents, to support continuity in their care and education.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she would support and deliver the educational programmes for children.
- The inspector sampled documentation, including policies and procedures.
