

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 18 June 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to safety and suitability of the premises, environment and equipment and accidents and injury. On 12 June 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to the same requirements.

On 14 July 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We also completed a regulatory telephone call on 17 July 2025. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has reviewed and improved their systems for monitoring and sharing risk assessments with key stakeholders, including parents and staff, to ensure that they are fully informed and can take action to keep children safe. In addition, the provider has made changes to their accident reporting procedures to ensure that all staff are clear on their responsibilities in ensuring that all relevant safeguarding partners are informed where required.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
