

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 April 2026, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment.

On 8 May 2026, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 22 May 2026:

- ensure that risk assessments are in place to keep staff and children safe.
- ensure that staff are aware of the whistleblowing procedures for the setting.
- ensure that staff are aware of the safer sleeping guidance and put this into practice.
- ensure that arrangements are in place for children with special educational needs and/or disabilities.

On 20 May 2026, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider has now put risk assessments in place. They have also improved their knowledge and understanding of whistleblowing procedures and safer sleep across the setting. They have also put arrangements in place for children with special educational needs and/or disabilities. For example putting in place individual education plans and following a graduated approach. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply

with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
