

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 11 April 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to EYFS safety on outings.

On 21 July 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has reviewed and improved their risk assessments when transporting children on outings to help ensure they remain safe.

On 17 July 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to EYFS supporting and understanding children's behaviour.

On 21 July 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 15 September 2025:

- improve your knowledge and understanding of children's behaviour and ensure strategies used in response to behaviour are age appropriate and promote children's emotional well-being at all times.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the action is successfully completed. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
