

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

Outcome summary – Bosede Olufowobi

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the [Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage](#). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 7 June 2021, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 28 June 2021, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We issued actions for the provider to take within the timescale set out below. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 12 July 2021:

- improve knowledge of safeguarding, identifying signs and symptoms of abuse and how to respond to this in a timely and appropriate way

- improve knowledge and understanding of what must be notified to Ofsted.

On the 21st August 2021 the provider informed us that they have updated their knowledge of safeguarding and identifying signs and symptoms of abuse. They had also updated their knowledge of events and changes that need to be notified to Ofsted.

We are satisfied the provider has now met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
