Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder knows the signs that mean a child may be at risk. She knows the correct procedures to follow to report her concerns. She understands how to provide a safe environment for children.
- The childminder knows how to carry out observations and assessments to help her identify any gaps in children's progress and how to take steps to close them.
- The childminder understands how to help children gain confidence and independence, and how to behave well to help prepare them for school.
- The childminder knows how to evaluate her practice to identify any strengths and weaknesses, and how to make improvements to benefit children. She understands the importance of increasing her knowledge and skills to meet the needs of children.
- The childminder understands the importance of working with parents to develop strong partnerships and further support children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
