This home is owned by a private company. It provides care for up to two children who may have experienced adverse childhood experiences that have led to associated trauma and presenting complex behaviours.

The manager is suitably qualified and is registered with Ofsted.

This monitoring visit

No children have lived in the home since May 2022. This visit was completed as the provider intends to move children into the home.

In preparation for the home to be reopened, the provider has made the decision to vary their conditions of registration. This includes reducing the number of children that can live at the home from three to two and removing the requirement to give Ofsted three months' notice of any child moving in. Ofsted have agreed to these changes of conditions of registration.

A new manager has been appointed, and they are registered with Ofsted. The manager is experienced, knowledgeable and holds the relevant qualification. In addition, a new responsible individual has been appointed.

A new staff team has been recruited. The staff team is made up of both experienced staff and those who are new to residential care. The staff who are now in post have completed the required training ready for any children to move in. Some staff are going through the safer recruitment process and will complete their induction once this is complete.

The home has been fully redecorated throughout and has been finished to an excellent standard. The home is ready for children to move in.
