Brief description of the service

The children's home is provided by a private company and cares for up to six children and young people with emotional and behavioural difficulties. Most children and young people are cared for in the main house but one child is also cared for in a detached bungalow situated in the rear garden.

Outcome of monitoring visit

The purpose of this visit was to assess compliance with the following notice served on the provider on 27 August 2014.

A compliance notice was issued under Regulation 23 Hazards and Safety. The registered person needed to ensure that; All parts of the home to which children have access are so far as reasonably practicable free from hazards to their health or safety and; Any activities in which children participate are so far as reasonably practical free from avoidable risks. All risk assessments were up to date and meaningful. This notice had been fully met.
