This inspection

This home was judged good at the last full inspection. At this interim inspection the home was '**not judged**'.

The home has not accommodated children and young people since November 2014. The house is being refurbished and a new boiler has been fitted. The manager has indicated that the home will not be accommodating children and young people until at least May 2015. Should the home decide to accept placements they are required to inform Ofsted of their intention before they do so.

The home is registered to provide care and accommodation for two young people. It may also provide transitional care for young people entering into adulthood for a specified period of time. The home is owned by a private organisation.
